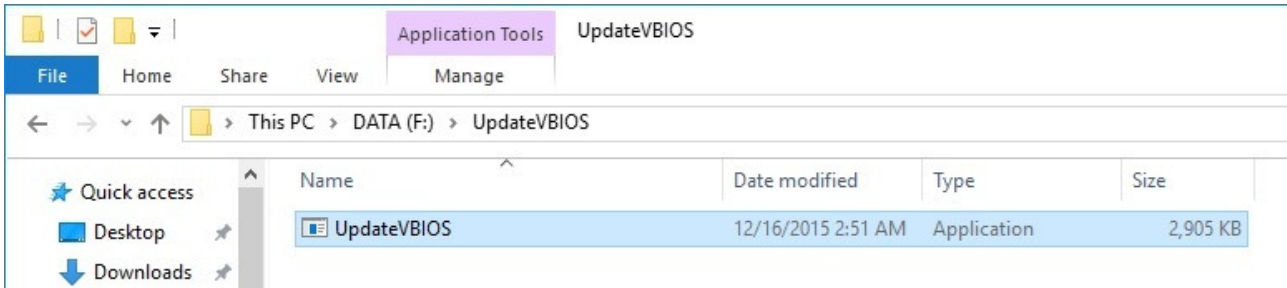


1. Open the “UpdateVBIOS” folder and execute “UpdateVBIOS.exe” .

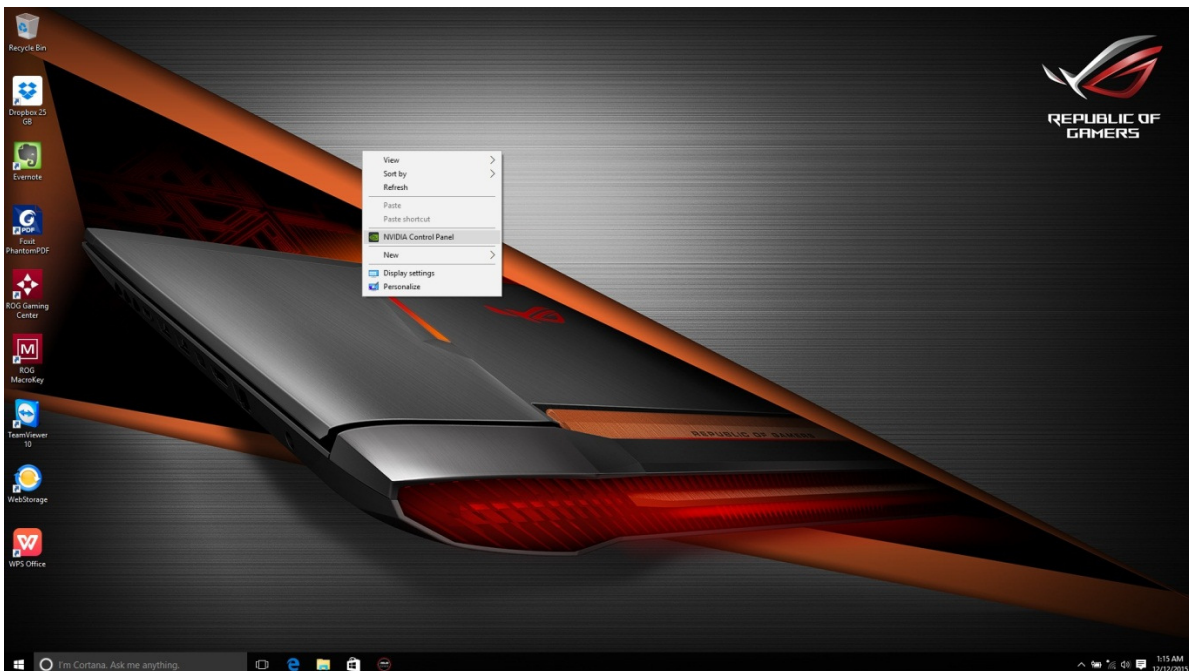
